PATIO WEATHER / WHITE WINE / \$30

2018 LA FIERA veneto, italy (pinot grigio)

This wine has a straw color and a fruity bouquet. The palate is dry, soft, and well balanced. It is a fresh and crisp wine, both floral and fruity; it expresses ripe peach and apple flavors with a subtle mineral finish.

2017 LORD SANDWICH blanc sonoma county, california (sauvignon blanc blend)

A blend of our gorgeous tank fermented Russian River Valley Sauvignon Blanc with a few barrels of Dutton Ranch Chardonnay and a generous splash of refreshing Verdelho from the Contra Costa AVA. It's the ultimate summer wine.

2017 STOLPMAN VINEYARDS ballard canyon, santa barara, california (sauvignon blanc)

A quintessential Stolpman Sauvignon Blanc with a fresh blast of Limestone-driven energy. The crisp, bright profile binds with the substantive weight and texture of the mid-palate to create a wine perfect for a farm-fresh dinner of veggies and seafood. Hints of citrus, tropical fruit, golden brush, and riper pear elements abound.

2017 GROTH napa valley, california (chardonnay)

Whole-cluster pressed 81% of the Chardonnay fruit, giving juice with incredibly delicate fruit flavors and softness. The remaining fruit was destemmed prior to pressing, yielding juice with a bigger structure and rich aromatics. After pressing and cold settling, the juice was transferred to French oak barrels, 16% new, for fermentation and aging. Notes of ripe pear, white peach, orange blossom and meyer lemon. The hint of new oak brings a sweetness that lifts the fruit and provides a bit of structure that supports the mouthfeel.

ROSÉ ALL DAY / \$30

2019 OLIVARES jumilla, spain (grenache)

Excellent balance of bright acidity, refreshing fruit and a clean and dry finish. Harvested during the first half of September.

Extraction of the must and fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

2018 SOKOL LOSSER willamette valley, oregon (pinot noir)

100% pinot noir grapes to produce our classic dry rosé. Crisp and vibrant, this wine features aromas of white peach, jasmine and spring rain. Nectarines, fresh melon and bright acidity are prominent on the palate with a lingering rhubarb flavor on the finish.

2019 BANSHEE mendocino county, california

(48% sangiovese, 25% grenache, 16% syrah, 8% barbera, 3% zinfandel)

The 2019 Mendocino County Rosé is a lovely shade of pale salmon with aromas of rose water, salinity and fresh picked strawberries. Bright flavors of juicy cantaloupe and honeydew melon are highlighted by a touch of Meyer lemon. Racy acidity and elegance are balanced perfectly in this dry, crisp Rosé.

2018 DOMAINE DE FIGUEIRASSE 'gris de gris' provence, france (field blend - grenache/cinsault)

This Rosé is dry, lively and refreshing. Aromas and flavors of tangy red cherries, pomegranate, fresh ginger, white pepper.

Just 200 yards from the Mediterranean coastline, estate vineyards are influenced by the sea. Humidity keeps the vines from suffering hydric stress; sea salt, acting as a natural antiseptic, keeps rootstock healthy.

SUMMER ROMANCE / RED WINE \$35

2017 LOVE & SQUALOR willamette valley, oregon (pinot noir)

The 2017 is a multi-vineyard, multi-appellation blend intended to capture the essence of the vintage. The grapes were mostly de-stemmed into small lot fermentations - un-inoculated and punched down by hand. Aged in small (225L) neutral french oak barrels for 18 months.

2018 BANSHEE sonoma county, california (pinot noir)

Handpicked and destemmed, fruit was fermented in small, stainless steel fermenters at cool temperatures for an average of 21 days. Aging for 16 months in 35% new French oak - Cavin, Tremeaux, Dargaud, François Frères & Jaegle barrels. The flavors combine both sweet and tart, reminiscent of Santa Rosa plums and wild blackberries. The finish is bright, slightly herbal, and savory making this an excellent food wine, as well as a charming drinking experience by itself.

2017 TRUCHARD ESTATE carneros, napa valley, california (cabernet sauvignon)

Cabernet Sauvignon is planted in several different sites on steep, southwestern facing hillsides. Luscious aromas of raspberry, plum and cassis fill your senses with a touch of cedar and vanilla. Layers of ripe cherries, red currants and berry jam provide a rich mouth feel. Ripe tannins focus the palate and provide a lengthy finish of spice and deep red fruit.

2015 SMITH STORY 'pickberry vineyard' (cabernet sauvignon)

The hand-harvested grapes arrived to the winery at sunrise for hand sorting. After destemming the grapes then went into tank for controlled whole berry fermentation. After a slow fermentation the wine was aged in 2-4 year old French Bordeaux barrels for 21 months before bottling. The Cabernet Sauvignon reveals focus on texture, structure and ageability. This wine is supremely generous and approachable in its youth, however, we believe its elegance and power make a strong argument for cellaring over the next 10 years.

WELL TRAVELED / RED WINE \$35

2017 VIETTI 'tre vigne' piedmont, italy (barbera)

Barriques, big oak barrels and steel tanks for approximately 18 months. Ruby purple color with ripe red cherry aromas with hints sweet spices. A dry, medium bodied red wine with refreshing acidity, the Barbera d'Asti Tre Vigne is well balanced with good integration of oak, good complexity and a long finish of red cherries.

2018 VIÑA BORGIA campo de borja, spain (garnacha)

Temperature controlled fermentation at between 22° C and 25° C in stainless steel tanks, where all the aromas are preserved. Done after a 15 days maceration period. Fresh bright red fruit balanced by a fine structure and ample bouquet. Viña Borgia is made from 100% Grenache and is a fine example of this varietal. This wine is vinified with utmost care and bottled under the strict supervision of the winemaker, José Luis Chueca Sancho.

2018 FELINO mendoza, argentina (rmalbec)

Fermented with selected and native yeasts in 8- and 17- ton closed-top stainless-steel tanks. Aged in American oak barrels (10% new) for 8 months. Bottled in February 2019. Unfined. Bright and deep purple color. Aromas of black fruit reminiscent of fresh plum mixed with graphite notes. On the palate the wine is balanced and energetic, with sweet and round tannins and long finish.

2017 LE MISTRAL monterey county, california (grenache/sirah/petit verdot)

This vintage of Joseph's Blend is juicy, spicy, and well structured thanks to a subtle addition of Petite Sirah. Fruit forward with luscious notes of cherry and raspberry, the bouquet opens to reveal black pepper, cured meat, and Herb de Provence with rich and creamy vanilla and toasty crème brûlée to round out the spiciness.
